

FULL-FRAME VERSUS INSERT REPLACEMENT WINDOWS

What's the difference?

In a full-frame replacement, the window and all trim are removed.

In an insert replacement, only the sashes and hardware are removed.



Full-frame replacement allows for a more complete upgrade to energy efficient and non-rot materials.

Insert replacement is generally less expensive and less time-consuming.

Choose full-frame replacement if you want to change the style, color, or size of your window.

Insert replacement should only be done on structurally sound windows.



In full-frame replacement, no glass space is lost (unless you want a smaller window)

Glass space is lost in insert replacement.
